 - Virtual, in-person, admissions events, community events
 - Track dates and deadlines
- APPLY! (July-January)
 - Application for Admission:
 - Application
 - LAIS Forms (Teacher Recommendations, Transcripts)
 - Interview, Screening/Assessment, and Visit Appointments*
 - Standardized Testing, writing samples*
 - Apply for Financial Aid (if applicable)
- **□** DECISIONS & ENROLLMENT DEADLINES (March & possibly rolling)
 - Admission and Financial Aid Decisions released in Early March
 - Enrollment due shortly after (all shared LAIS dates)

1) EXPLORE WEBSITES (NOW!)

2) INQUIRE/MAKE PLANS TO VISIT (Spring, Summer, Fall)

- Go to the school websites and submit basic family information some schools allow you to do this years in advance!
- Dates and Deadlines
- Plan to come for an event! (on campus or virtual)

Applications & Decisions

3) SUBMIT & COMPLETE APPLICATIONS (Summer through early Winter)

Some schools start the process with an application rather than an Inquiry Form

- Application for Admission:
 - Application & Fee
 - Teacher Recommendations (LAIS Teacher Recommendation Form)
 - Grades/Standardized Testing/Transcripts (LAIS Transcript/Records Form)
 - Standardized Testing*
 - Student Screening/Evaluation/Assessment/Play-Date/Visit Day*
 - Interview*
- Apply for Financial Aid (if applicable)

4) DECISIONS/ENROLLMENT (March and sometimes ongoing)

- Admission and Financial Aid Decisions released the 2nd Friday in March
- Enrollment Contracts (typically online), deposits, new student fees
- Wait Lists
- Rolling Admission
